

## Jean Charlot Commonweal Project


Jean Charlot (1898-1979) Hawaiʻi based painter, illustrator and educator famous for frescoes and lithography.


Charlot's personal papers are housed at the University of Hawai'i Hamilton Library under the supervision of archivist Bronwen Solyom. *Commonweal* (Catholic publication) "The founders of *Commonweal* announced that the publication would be loyal to the church but that it would be edited and published by laymen independently of ecclesiastical control." (Jordan, P., 1994)


## **Archival Process**



Selection, Appraisal and Acquisition: Charlot began series of 'processed works, 1938' in personal files. Archivist compiled illustrated work from 1938-2013 from library's deaccessioned journals.







Preservation concerns: Brittle paper Access: Increased access to illustrations through digitization of physical clippings.
